Thank you for your enquiry dated 6th October 2006. I am glad to acknowledge safe receipt of all the necessary information regarding Di Chem Tiestop.

I can therefore confirm that Tiestop is considered as falling under Regulation 31 (4) (b), as having a small surface area in contact with water. As it is already WRAS approved (Ref. No: 0607507), it can be used without any further testing.
